Inner fat and inner organs taken out. Breast waved. Thigh heaved.	Inner fat and inner organs, with a burnt offering, meal offering and drink offering.	Breast and thigh. Remaining flesh was eaten by the offerer himself	Probably disposed of with ashes of burnt offering.	Thanksgiving, fellowship and worship.
