FEAST	DAY	REF.:	OFFERING MADE	OTHER DETAILS
PASSOVER	14th day of 1st month (Nisan)	Ex. 12:1-28 Num. 9:1-14 Deut. 16:1-7 Luke 22:7-20	Male lamb of 1st year, without blemish	No leaven anywhere in their houses. A kid of the goats was permissible. Blood put on door posts with hyssop. Meat had to be roasted and eaten with unleavened bread and bitter herbs.
UNLEAVENED BREAD	For 7 days	Lev. 23:6-8 Num. 28:17-25 Deut. 16:8	<u>Burnt Offering</u> - 2 young bullocks, 1 ram, 7 lambs of 1st year <u>Meal Offering</u> - various amounts with each animal of burnt offering * <u>Sin Offering</u> - 1 goat All to be offered each day for the 7 days	The 1st and 7th days were to be sabbaths. No leaven could be eaten during this feast.
FIRSTFRUITS	'the morrow after the sabbath' (Nisan)	Lev. 23:9-14 Lev. 2:15-21 Num. 28:26-31	A male lamb of 1st year as burnt offering, with meal & drink offering <u>Burnt Offering</u> - 2 young bullocks, 1 ram, 7 lambs of 1st year <u>Meal Offering</u> - various amounts with each animal of burnt offering * <u>Sin Offering</u> - 1 kid of the goats	A sheaf of first fruits was brought to the priest to be waved. The harvest was not to be eaten until the first fruits had been offered to God. (see also Exo. 34:26; Deut. 26:1-11)
PENTECOST (Weeks)	50th day after Firstfruits (Sivan)	Lev. 23:15-21 Deut. 16:9-12 Acts 2	<u>Burnt Offering</u> - 1 young bullock, 1 ram, 7 lambs of 1st year <u>Meal & Drink Offering</u> - with each animal of burnt offering * <u>Sin Offering</u> - 1 kid of the goats <u>Peace Offering</u> - 2 lambs of 1st year	2 loaves of fine flour and leaven to be waved with peace offering.
TRUMPETS (New Year)	1st day of 7th month (Tishri)	Lev. 23:23-25 Num. 10:1-10 Num. 29:1-6	<u>Burnt Offering</u> - 1 young bullock, 1 ram, 7 lambs of 1st year <u>Meal Offering</u> - various amounts with each animal of burnt offering * <u>Sin Offering</u> - 1 kid of the goats	Priests blew trumpets throughout the day.
DAY OF ATONEMENT	10th day of 7th month (Tishri)	Lev. 16 Lev. 23:26-32 Lev. 25:8-9 Num. 29:1-6	<u>Sin Offering</u> - 1 bullock, 2 male goats <u>Burnt Offering</u> - 2 rams <u>Burnt Offering</u> - 1 young bullock, 1 ram, 7 lambs of 1st year <u>Meal Offering</u> - various amounts with each animal of burnt offering * <u>Sin Offering</u> - 1 kid of the goats	Particular emphasis made of the principle of ceasing from all labours and humbling oneself before God. In the year of jubilee, the trumpet was to be sounded throughout the whole land on this day.
TABERNACLES (Booths) (Ingathering)	15th day of 7th month (Tishri) for 6 days	Lev. 23:33-44 Num. 29:12-38 Deut. 16:13-15 Neh. 8:14-18	<u>Burnt Offering</u> - 1 young bullock, 1 ram, 7 lambs of 1st year <u>Meal Offering</u> - various amounts with each animal of burnt offering * <u>Sin Offering</u> - 1 kid of the goats All to be offered each day for 7 days, except that the number of bullocks was reduced by 1 each day. On the 8th day, the following offerings were made :- <u>Burnt Offering</u> - 1 young bullock, 1 ram, 7 lambs of 1st year <u>Meal & Drink Offering</u> - with each animal of burnt offering * <u>Sin Offering</u> - 1 goat	The 1st and 8th days were to be sabbaths. On the 1st day the people made booths, using thick branches such as palm or willow. They had to dwell in these booths for the duration of the feast. Traditionally, Psalm 118 was recited while branches of palm trees were waved.
NEW MOONS	Beginning of every month	Num. 10:1-10 Num. 28:11-15 Psa. 81:3	<u>Burnt Offering</u> - 2 young bullocks, 1 ram, 7 lambs of 1st year <u>Meal & Drink Offering</u> - with each animal of burnt offering * <u>Sin Offering</u> - 1 kid of the goats	Priests blew trumpets. See also 2 Chron. 29:26-28.

* with bullock - $\frac{3}{10}$ ephah fine flour, $\frac{1}{2}$ hin oil, $\frac{1}{2}$ hin wine; with ram - $\frac{2}{10}$ ephah fine flour, $\frac{1}{3}$ hin oil, $\frac{1}{3}$ hin wine; with lamb - $\frac{1}{10}$ ephah fine flour, $\frac{1}{4}$ hin oil, $\frac{1}{4}$ hin wine.
